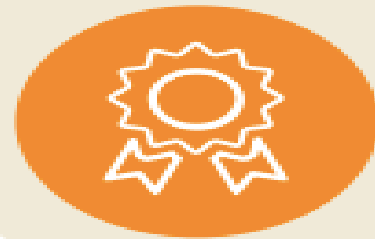

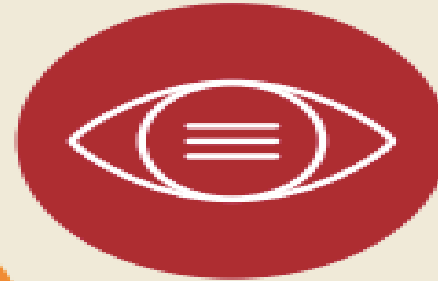

# Benefits of indexing in DOAJ

- Getting indexed in DOAJ:
- Reputation and prominence
- increases journal visibility
- fosters trust
- improves citations
- attracts submissions
- is often a requirement for procuring OA funding

# What is an XML file?

- An eXtensible Markup Language (XML) file is a text-based document that you can save with the .xml extension. used to store, structure and transport data.
- To create or edit an XML file, you can use any of the following: Text editors like Notepad or Notepad++ and all of web browsers
- Tag: tags define the structure and meaning of your data.

# Article Metadata

Metadata means “data about the data” — in this case, information about the article that is not part of the body text or graphics of the article, for example,

1. Title
2. the authorship information(First Name, Middle Name, Last Name and Their affiliation, ORCID ID)
3. publication date
4. Abstract
5. Keywords
6. any unique identifiers, copyrights, etc. that serves to identify or describe the article.

# Upload article XML

- First convert your article metadata into an accepted XML format: DOAJ Crossref.
  - DOAJ accepts DOAJ Native XML, Crossref 4.4.2 XML, or Crossref 5.3.1 XML
- If you are creating DOAJ XML manually, try formatting and validating the file before you upload it to DOAJ.
- If you are exporting XML from an OJS plugin, you can upload the file immediately.
