When journal is indexed

- Having your journal indexed gives potential authors a sense of whether or not they can trust your journal.
- When a journal is indexed, it has met certain minimum expectations regarding things like peer review policies and ethics standards.
- It tells potential authors that your journal is a known factor.

• When you index your journal, you are communicating something about your business. You are telling people that you are serious about Scholarly publishing, and that you want to produce a high quality journal.

- Authors who publish in your journal will have a greater peace of mind, knowing that their work will be indexed and accessible to others.
- Being diligent about how your articles get treated after getting published will ultimately benefit your business, so make sure you start off on the right foot.

Minimum criteria

be considered for review, journal titles should meet all of these minimum criteria:

o Consist of peer-reviewed content and have a publicly available description of the peer review process

 Be published on a regular basis and have an International Standard Serial Number (ISSN) as registered with the <u>ISSN International</u> <u>Centre opens in new tab/window</u>

- Have content that is relevant for and readable by an international audience, meaning: have English language abstracts and titles, references
- Have a publicly available publication ethics and publication malpractice statement

Applications for new journal and publisher memberships are temporarily closed while we implement a new and improved application and assessment process.

Please be patient as we work to implement the new policies and processes across our systems. This will also allow potential applicants the time to review and consider our new requirements. To help you prepare for the new process please review the guidance on this page which will help you with your application to ensure a positive outcome when we reopen for applications in 2025.



<u>Read the background on why we have implemented a new application process</u>

COPE has undertaken a comprehensive review of its membership application process over the past 12 months. Key improvements include:

- 1. Clarifying expectations for potential members
- 2. Providing clearer website guidance
- 3. Streamlining the application form with clearer language
- 4. Developing consistent assessment criteria
- 5. Implementing continuous review post-membership
- 6. Improving efficiency and response times

Eligibility for journal membership

The journal must agree to abide by COPE's Code of Conduct and Membership Terms & Conditions (to be launched soon).

• The journal must be an editor or peer-reviewed scholarly journal that has been publishing for at least one year and has published a minimum of 20 original research articles in accordance with the publicly stated publication schedule.

- The journal must publish at least five scholarly articles per year.
- Editor-in-Chief's CV or other form of evidence to demonstrate clear editorial governance by appropriately qualified individuals or team must be provided. (If a CV is provided, it must include the last 5 years employment history).
- Applications have to meet all of the minimum criteria.

Minimum criteria for COPE membership

- policy on handling appeals
- policy on authorship and contributorship
- policies on potential conflicts of interest of editors (including guest editors), authors, reviewers, publisher/journal owner, and journal staff

- policy on correction and retraction
- policies on data fabrication and falsification
- policies on intellectual property (plagiarism)
- policies and processes on peer review (including reviewer responsibilities, handling of papers authored by editorial board members)

- The copyright and licensing information
- what fees are applied, how much they are, when and how they are charged. For example: article processing charges (APCs), colour charges, page charges
- a statement if there are no fees

- what arrangements are in place for the long-term digital preservation of papers
- ethics approval (where required)
- informed consent (where required)

A statement on ALL article PDFs (where appropriate) stating:

- any conflicts of interest (noting none if not applicable)
- copyright and / or licensing
- the corresponding author contact email address
- the journal/article identifiers, for example, ISSN or DOI
